



OLIVER RANCH GROUP TOUR INFORMATION Saturday, September 14, 2019

We will meet as a group at the <u>Geyserville Park & Ride</u> on Remmell Road (one block east of Geyserville Ave, next to the railroad tracks) by 9:15 AM. Street parking and a limited number of Park & Ride spots will be available. We will begin loading the buses around 9:30 AM with a strict departure time of 9:45 AM. Your timely arrival is greatly appreciated, as we cannot delay our arrival to Oliver Ranch.

<u>Personal vehicles are not allowed access to the Ranch</u> so all guests must arrive and leave together on one of MCD's provided buses. It is a quick 5-minute ride to and from the Ranch.

Upon arrival, our tour will begin promptly at 10:00 AM and will last 2.5 hours. The tour covers approximately 2.5 miles with 600 feet of up and down elevation change. It can be likened to a light hike in the woods as the paths are unpaved. The tour is not wheelchair accessible and comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Please also note, there are no restroom facilities available at Oliver Ranch so we ask you to make a restroom stop before loading onto the bus (the <u>Geyserville Coffee Company</u> is a short block from the Park & Ride for restrooms). Smoking is prohibited while on Ranch property, and pets are not permitted. Still photography is allowed except in the guest house interior. Video is only allowed when Steve and/or docents are not speaking.

Once the tour is complete, we will load back on the buses and drop off at the Park & Ride around 1:00 PM. Personal water bottles and energy bars are allowed, but no other food is permitted on Oliver Ranch. Lunch will not be provided but there is an assortment of restaurants to choose from in the area including Diavola Pizzeria & Salumeria, Catelli's, and the SHED in Healdsburg.
